

Seminar on surviving separation

SPECIALIST family lawyer Michael Lynch will hold a seminar entitled Surviving Separation at Mt Ommaney's McLeod Country Golf Club on July 27 and USQ Springfield on August 4.

Mr Lynch has 20 years experience dealing with couples going through separation and said there had been a constant stream of changes in the law over that period.

Mr Lynch, who runs city firm Michael Lynch Family Lawyers, said law changes had occurred in relation to parenting arrangements, superannuation, property agreements, child support and de facto relationships.
